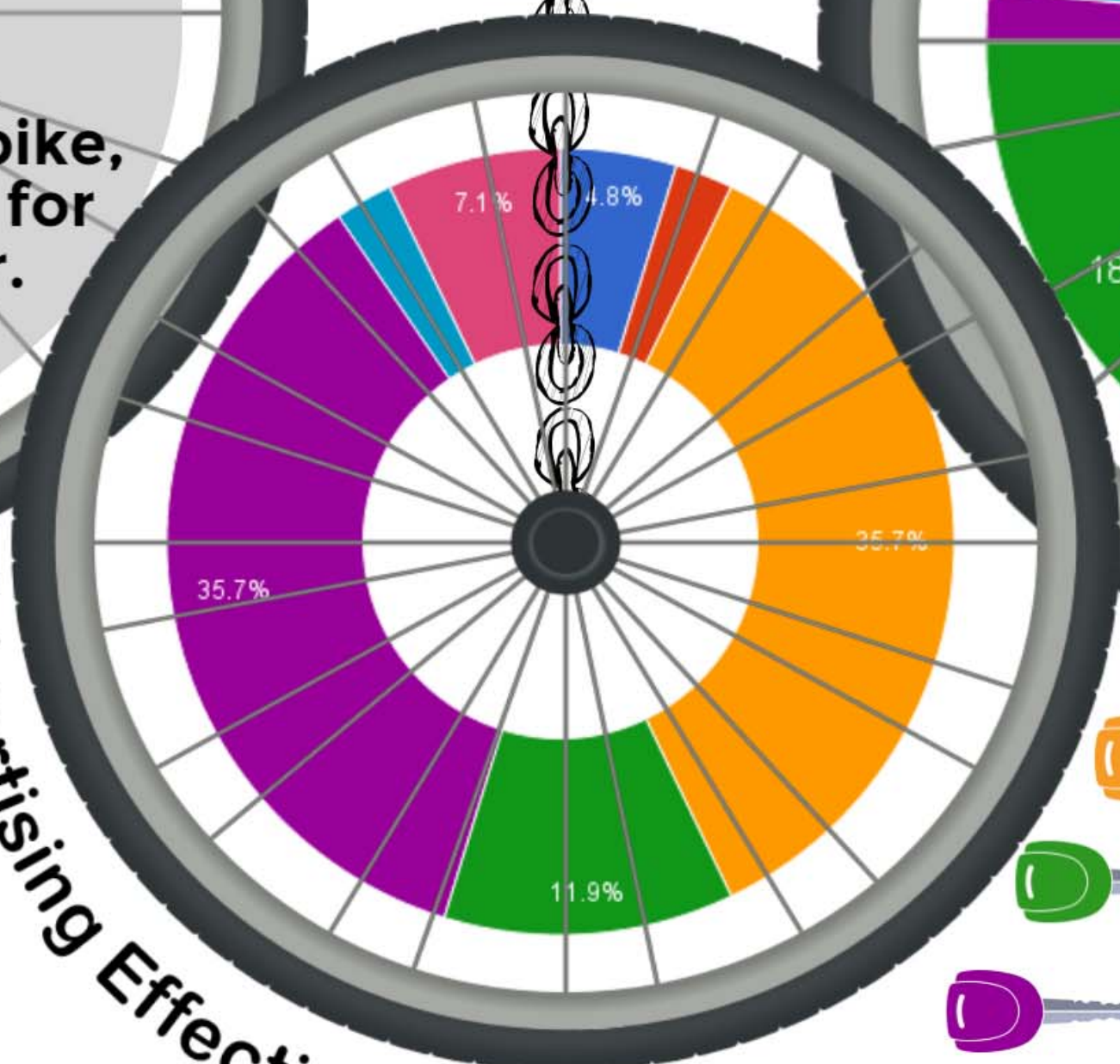
**Mission:**

Heller Service Corps now partners with Village Wrench allowing a way for students to volunteer in the Greenville community.

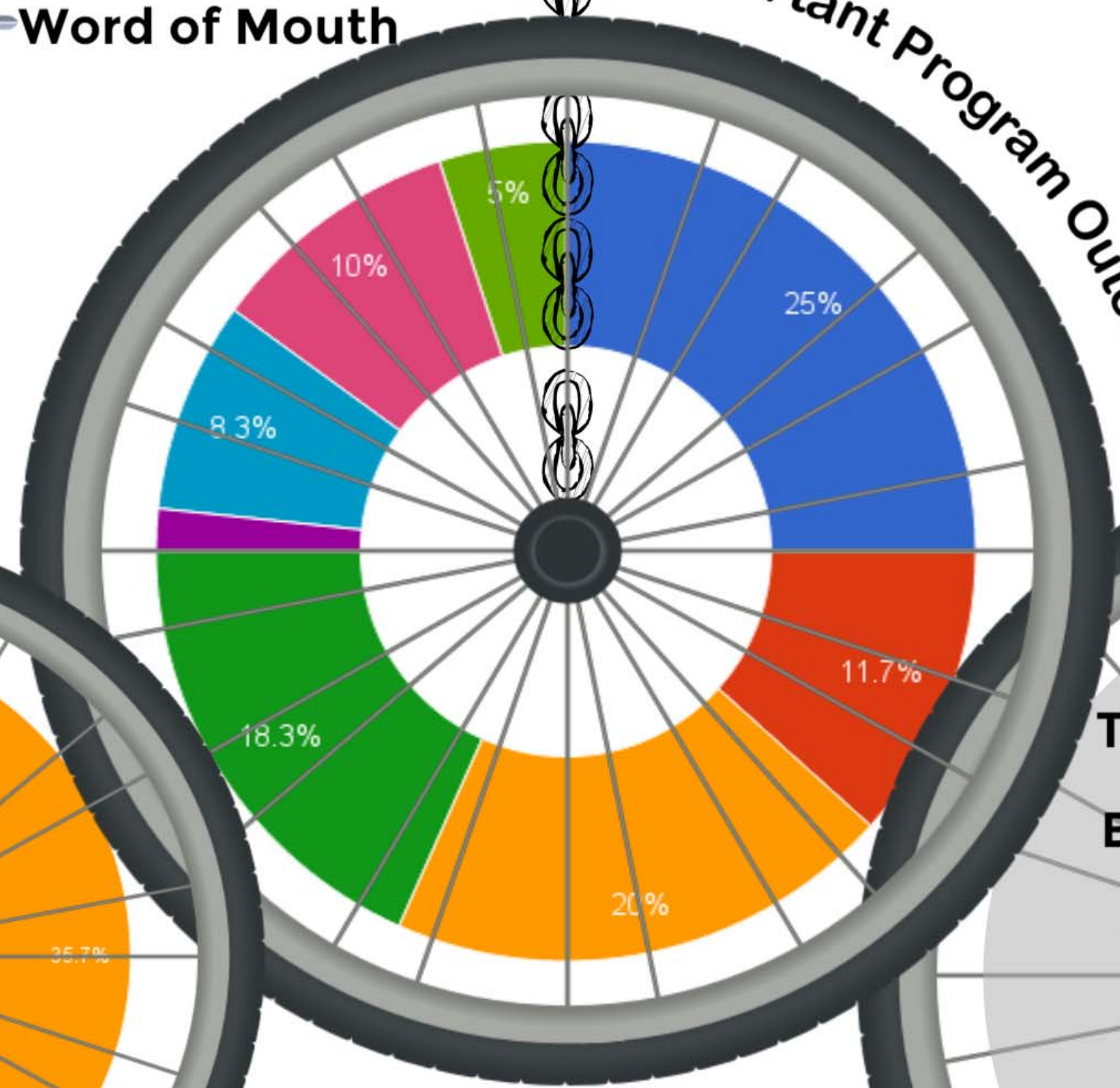
