Gower was one of 14 women from the Class of '42 who gathered at Cherrydale in October for their annual mini-reunion. The group began the gatherings more than 20 years ago in the home of Marjorie Bunch Greene, then later shifted their meeting site to Greenville's Poinsett Club.

Greene planned this year's event, the first to be held at Cherrydale, but died before it took place. In her honor, her classmates purchased a sterling silver bowl to grace the dining room table at the Alumni House.
